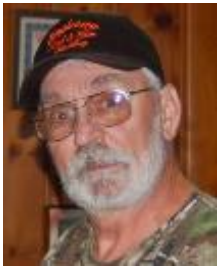

Please sweep up your empty brass. The range rules are posted at the back of the roof area for your review. Anyone not following the range rules could be suspended or expelled from the club. The rifle range is now under video surveillance 24/7. Any loaded ammo, whether it's ammo you don't want or misfired ammo must not be thrown in the trash barrels. There is a red metal box attached to one of the posts for discarding this type of ammo. Pistol results after sixteen shoots:
