

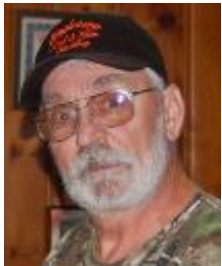
Singletary Rod & Gun Club June 2018
